



The Eva Johnson Memorial Scholarship Fund Scoring System & Procedure

Scoring

The Eva Johnson Memorial Scholarship Fund application scoring system uses a point system for each of the following criteria: application (10 possible points), academic achievement (20 possible points), school and community involvement (10 possible points), references (10 possible points), and overall written essay (50 possible points), which should include where and when you attended Shasta Head Start as a child and benefits received from the program, future educational goals, community service performed, future community/society service goals, personal life goals and career goals.

Before the review meeting, assigned reviewers will determine preliminary scores for each of the scored review criteria and a preliminary overall score for each applicant. The Scholarship Committee will then meet as a group to review all the students' applications. The scores will assist the Committee in the selection process of the scholarship winners.

All decisions of the Scholarship Committee are final.
